

Requirements for a Workplace, if Forklift or Order Picker assessment is to be done on-site

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be aware that a WHS Inspector maybe there at the time of assessment to audit the Trainee, the Employer and the Assessor 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is area for assessment over 400m² 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forklift 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Machine is in good working order i.e. data plate, seatbelt, beepers, manual
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 different loads (over 250 kgs each)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Order Picker 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capacity of machine is over 1000 kg – in good working order i.e. data plate, seatbelt, beepers, manual
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 different loads
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Order picker cannot have a fixed platform
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Barriers, signs or other items to create control measures for pedestrian zones 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Need High, Mid and Low racking OR stacks on site 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Racking must be bolted to the floor and comply with Australian Standards 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High lift (could be mezzanine) must be at least 75% of the lift height of the machine 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suitable area to perform practical assessment 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aware assessment may affect production 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please advise us of any on site requirements i.e. site induction, PPE, blue card that you need our assessor to comply with 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilities to do necessary paperwork without interruption
